

TWIN SISTERS TERRY and Linda Jamison not only know each other's thoughts, finish each other's sentences, experience the same dreams and suffer the same illnesses – they also share a strong psychic ability which is heightened

when they are together. "We are like one spirit connected by two bodies. We are twins with a psychic connection," Linda says.

It all started 40 years ago at a school fete, when the sisters, then aged five, were keen to win a "guess how many jellybeans are in the jar" competition. Terry knew exactly how many there were.

"I went up to this huge jar, held the container in my hands, shut my eyes and knew there were 457 jellybeans inside," she says. "It wasn't a guess - it was spot-on."

After that, the Pennsylvaniaraised girls began predicting eerie things about their friends - such as who they should date and who to avoid and what subjects they should study. They told one friend to go into journalism, and he went on to become a successful TV presenter.

They would also watch crimeinvestigation shows and solve them before the programs were over.

"We did get persecuted a little - we were called the weird twins," Terry laughs. "But we always had each other. Mostly, we didn't talk about it... we were from a small country town where people didn't talk about things like psychics.

"We fought it at first, but then we realised it was part of our life

purpose to have this gift. We don't understand it, but we're so grateful."

Today, Terry and Linda work mainly through automatic writing, which they describe as "channelled" or "spirit writing".

"It's like we connect with a broader knowing or our spirit guides," Linda says. "Afterwards, we compare notes and nearly always have written the same thing. We reinforce each other's information and psychic feelings."

Sensing danger

The twins, who live and work together in LA and are known professionally as the Psychic Twins, have the dubious distinction of being the only psychics in the world to have predicted the terrorist attacks on the US on September 11, 2001.

They did this on an American radio show,

telling some 20 million listeners that simultaneous

attacks masterminded by Osama bin Laden would be made on the World Trade Center in New York City and other government

As with many of their predictions, no-one listened - until the attacks happened. The US Government then shut down the twins' website.

"Can you imagine just how frustrating that was? What's the point of having this gift if we are not heard?" Terry says.

"It was momentous for us, and very upsetting, but I think people are gradually becoming more open to

"Sadly, the stresses of their work schedules will cause a separation," the twins add, admitting they don't always



The Psychic Twins say
Olivia Newton-John will see her missing boyfriend Patrick McDermott again. but the reunion will mark the end of their romance.

Terry and Linda Jamison's startling predictions on a leading US television show nine months ago changed the course of police investigations.

Patrick disappeared last year in mysterious circumstances off a fishing boat in California.

The twins were the first to claim that 38-year-old Patrick was not dead but had faked his disappearance and gone on the run to Mexico.
"At first the police were

convinced he had been murdered or committed suicide. They had given the owners of the boat a difficult time and put them through hell," Terry explains.

"After the show aired, we got a letter from the owners thanking us - they were so grateful we had gotten the police off their backs."

Terry and Linda believed he faked his disappearance to avoid financial problems, and was travelling south to Mexico. They even described a black pick-up truck, which has since been linked with sightings of Patrick. They also claimed a dark-haired man in his thirties helped stage the disappearance.

"Olivia had no idea what he was planning," say Linda and Terry. "It's been a difficult time for her. We don't feel he stopped loving her, but he found himself in a bad situation and couldn't get out of it."

However, like her marriage break-up and breast-cancer battle, the experience will make Olivia, 57, stronger.

"She is very strong spiritually and her luck is going to turn, which often happens when you've lost a lot of things," Terry says.

"She's going to have a reunion with him, and then she is going to have a very good year."
